THE SNOW GLOBE

C R A F T I N G I N S T R U C T I O N S

YOU NEED THIS MATERIALS:

- empty jar of jam
- white glue
- silicone adhesive
- glue gun
- distilled water

- one drop of dish soap
- cutter/ pliers
- brush/ mixed palette
- silverspray
- acrylic color

At first you take the palette. Mixed on it the white glue with glitter. We mixed gold and silver glitter.

Depending on the color of the lid, you can prime the lid with white acrylic paint.



Now glue the Styrofoam hemisphere in the middle of the lid with hot glue. Grab the silicone adhesive and spread it over the hemisphere. Scatter the artificial snow on the silicone adhesive and press it down a little. The drying time is about 24 hours.



When everything has dried, you filled the glass to the brim with distilled water and a drop of dish soap.

Caution: Do not use too much soap so that it does not foam. It ensures that the glitter doesn't clump and the snow slowly trickles down.



- Styrofoam ball Ø 7cm
- Confetti,glitter...
- Artificial snow
- Cutting mat



Brush the lid generously with the glue-glitter mixture and let it dry well while you are designing the ball.

Now cut the Styrofoam ball in half and preheat your glue gun.



Iln the meantime, you already can spray your christmas tree with silver spray.

Unscrew the base from the fir tree and drill the wire (tree trunk) into the snow mountain with a little bit hot glue.



Finally, fill your glass with as much glitter, artificial snow and confetti as you want. You can seal the edge of the lid with silicone glue so that no water escapes from the glass. Now you close the glass

over a sink and the snow globe is ready.
